CLTAV & CLTAT 2024 *HANYUQIAO* CHINESE SPEAKING & PERFORMANCE COMPETITION

A. Introduction

The CLTAV & TASMANIA 2024 Chinese Bridge- Chinese Proficiency Competition for **Foreign Secondary School Language** students of Chinese is a free competition designed to select the best **THREE** senior students from Victorian and Tasmanian schools to take part in the 2024 online Australia's National *Hanyuqiao* Chinese Proficiency Competition on 25th May in Sydney and then International *Hanyuqiao* Chinese Proficiency Competition in China in late October 2024.

B. Date and Venue

Accordingly, the CLTAV & TASMANIA 2024 Chinese *Hanyuqiao* Speaking and Performance Competition will be held at Camberwell Grammar School on Friday evening, 17 May commencing at 6.00pm.

C. Eligibility

All candidates should be senior students (Year 10 and Year 11) enrolled in a Chinese second language course at a day school. Students must be born in a non-Chinese speaking country with both parents being non-native speakers of any form (dialect) of Chinese. Candidates should also have had no more than ten weeks of language experience through Chinese exchange or overseas study programs.

D. Entries

Maximum two (2) candidates (with photos) who meet the eligibility criteria per school. Please note that each school needs to send <u>the official CLTAV Competition Registration</u> <u>Forms</u> before **FRIDAY**, **3 MAY 2024** to the following:

E. Rules

(a) Format of Competition

There are two parts to the competition. One is **the written test** (20 minutes, 30 multiplechoice questions). The other is as follows: All Contestants will be required to deliver one speech (2-2 ½ minutes) and to perform one of the following cultural/artistic forms (2-3 minutes): Chinese songs, musical instruments, dance, folk music, acrobatics, calligraphy, painting, paper cutting, martial arts etc. (中国歌曲、音乐、舞蹈、曲艺、杂技、乐器、书法、绘画、剪纸、武术等)。

The topic of the competition: Chinese Title: 追梦中文,不负韶华 English title: Fly High with Chinese

Notes:

1.The content and form of the speech must be the work of the student taking part in the Competition.

2. Students can only seek guidance from his/her Chinese teacher in preparing for the Competition.

3. Teachers should <u>not</u> write or rewrite the Speech on behalf of the Student.

(b) Delivery of Speeches

1. Contestants will <u>not</u> be permitted to read their Prepared Speech verbatim. They will, however, be allowed to summarize the key points to be covered in their speech, on a single **Prompt Card** (A6 size).

2. Props or other aids will <u>not</u> be permitted.

(c) Judging Criteria for the speech

The following criteria will be used to assess the perfo	ormance of each contestant.	
1. Content	25 Marks	
Comprehensive treatment of topic & structured development of ideas		
2. Pronunciation	20 Marks	
Accuracy in sounds and tones		
3. Fluency	15 Marks	
Phrasing, Intonation, Pausing and Emphasis		
4. Presentation	10 Marks	
Feeling and Expression, Gestures, Use of Prompt Card and Timing		

(d) Judging Criteria for the cultural/artistic performance

The following criteria will be used to assess the performance of each contestant.

1. Artistic merit	10 Marks
2. Standard of achievement	10 Marks
3. Overall impression	10 Marks

F. Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded to the prize winners.

Second	\$150 (or equivalent value of a book voucher)
Third	\$100 (or equivalent value of a book voucher)

There will be also 6 medallions of encouragement.
