
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
### How to use Teams to deliver content?

1. Begin your post. Click on the format icon - A (underlined with paintbrush)


Type your announcement. Type @ to mention someone.

#### **Activities and Differentiation in Teams**

- Microsoft Teams offers a variety of tools to facilitate differentiation in lesson Familiar Apps -Word, Excel, PowerPoint enable content to be provided in familiar formats
- Video can be used to demonstrate how to write characters and to give instructions etc.
- Flash cards combining visual and audio cues, using Quizlet
- Easy access to tools such as Padlet, Google Docs and Google Forms etc
- Link tab back to School's Learning Management System

- Set up tasks that allow students to extend their abilities, e.g. in Year 7, we did 《我的偶像》after we studied Unit 1, Easy Steps to Chinese 3. This can be done in Word, PPT or iMovie etc. The students can choose what tool they use and they can choose to write about whom they like. There is flexibility.
- In Teams, channels can be set up. Students can have their own individual channel or they can be divided into groups. The teacher sets tasks for different groups to do and checks in to talk to each group. In addition, through sharing files, teachers can send different work to different students.
- In Teams, when setting up a lesson, it would have tasks that requires different skills and knowledge. Students can choose which one they do or they can start with the easy one and get to the difficult one.
- In Teams, differentiation can be achieved by giving feedback or support instantly online. Students can call or message/chat with the teacher. This enable the shy students to communicate with the teacher.
- In Teams, lessons can be recorded and weaker students can replay the recording.
