SHANGHAI

In Shanghai students live from Monday to Friday in shared rooms in their school dormitory. Weekends are spent with a host family from the school community.

Applicants to Shanghai must be between 16 and 18 years of age.

ZHENGZHOU

In Zhengzhou students live in fully supervised shared accommodation with local or international students from Monday to Friday and stay with a local host family from the school community on the weekends. Alternatively, students can also choose to live with a host family for their full program duration.

Applicants to Zhengzhou must be between 14 and 19 years of age.
